This day this Cause
coming on to be heard
upon the Defendant Judah Mead's Motion
for a new trial herein, and the Court
being, now fully advised overrules said
Motion, to which decision of the Court
the Defendant Mead by his Counsel Excepts

Therefore it is considered by the Court
that Plaintiff have and recover of said

Judah Mead as Garnisher of Nicholas O. Wiggins. The sum of one hundred and two dollars & sixty six cents being the amount due from said Wiggins to said Plaintiff and found due from said Mead to said Wiggins in form aforesaid, and also his costs and charges by him about this suit expended, and have Execution therefor to which Judgment Defendant Mead by his Council excepted, and prayed an appeal to the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois and offered S.W. Brown as security.

It is therefore ordered that the appeal be allowed, upon said Defendant Judah Mead entering into Bonds in the sum of Two Hundred dollars, with S.W. Brown as surety, in form to be approved by the Clerk of this Court, and filed within thirty days from date, and that the Bill of Exceptions be made out and filed by the first day of the next Term of this Court and filed by the Clerk in duplicate

And afterwards on the 26 day of November A.D. 1838 the said Defendant Judah Mead caused to be filed in the office of the Clerk of said Court a certain appeal bond in the sum of Two Hundred dollars with S.W. Brown as surety, which was approved by the Clerk of said Court and now can be found upon the files of said Court
