7 Trial by Court. Damages assessed at \$95.

Motion for new trial. Motion overruled and judgment for appellee.

8 Appeal prayed, and bond to be filed by Saturday next, with Thomas
W. Osborn, security.

Bill of exceptions.

9 Plaintiff below introduced in evidence a note, in the words as follows:
\$95.00. OTTAWA, Dec. 2, 1858.

Nine months after date, I promise to pay to the order of Augustus
Leckelt, ninety-five dollars, value received, with ten per cent. interest pr
annum. E. H. RAYMOND.

Indorsed: "A. Leckelt."

And the plaintiff offered to remit all the interest on the note, for the
express purpose of giving jurisdiction, and take judgment for \$95 only,
&c., and rested his case.

This was all the evidence.

Motion by defendant below to dismiss the suit for want of jurisdiction
in the Justice.

Motion overruled.

Motion for new trial, and motion overruled.

Errors assigned are,—

Overruling motion to dismiss for want of jurisdiction.

Overruling motion for new trial.

Rendering judgment for plaintiff below.
