

Know all men by these presents that we

Illinois are by these presents held and firmly
bound unto Harvey B. Hurd as Guardian &c
in the sum of Four Thousand Dollars lawful
money of the United States to be paid to the said
Harvey B. Hurd, his executors Administrators
or legal representatives, for the payment of
which well and truly to be made we hereby
bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and
Administrators. Given under our hands
and seals this 27th day February A.D. 1856.

The condition of the above obligation
is such that whereas on the 12th day of
January A.D. 1856 a decree was rendered
by the Circuit Court of Cook County, in favor
of Harvey B. Hurd as Guardian &c and
against J. Tilden Monilton and Charlotte
Hardin Monilton; and whereas the said J. Tilden
Monilton and Charlotte Hardin Monilton have
sued out of the Supreme Court of the State of
Illinois for the third Grand Division of said
State, a writ of Error returnable to the next
term of said Supreme Court, and have ap-
plied for a Supersedeas agreeably to the statu-
te in such case made and provided,
which has been allowed, Now if the

Said J. Tilden Moulton and Charles
Harden Moulton shall duly pro-
secute said writ of Error and pay the
said decree and all costs, interest and
damages in case the said decree shall
be affirmed, then the above obligation
shall be void, otherwise to be or remain
in full force and virtue.
