This cause came upon to be
heard upon the petition, publication
as to the defendants Francis Remynd and heirs of
Lupina as to the defendant Henry W. Underhill.
and the said defendants being thereupon called came
not but made default.

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed that said
petition be taken as confessed against said defendants
and this cause thereupon coming on for hearing
on the report of the Master in Chancery of this Court to
which it was referred to take an account of what

" Should be due to said plaintiffs by way of him on the
" premises in the petition set forth - for Confirmation of said
" report the Court do find that there is now due to said
" petitioners the sum of nineteen dollars of principal and
" the sum of one dollar of interest making in all the sum
" of twenty dollars.

" It is therefore ordered that the report of said Master
" stand confirmed in all things - that the said Francis
" Benjamin & Henry W. Underhill pay to the said Ira Corwin
" and Reuben Thompson the said sum of twenty dollars
" and also the costs of this suit within thirty days from the
" signing of this Court and in default of such payment that the
" Sheriff of this County for the time being, as a special
" Master Commissioner be directed to sell the said premises
" in said petition set forth and described to wit: Lot No. one
" (1) and two (2) with the appurtenances in Block No. twenty
" two (72) in said Town of LaSalle in the County and State
" aforesaid or so much of said premises as may be
" necessary to satisfy and pay the amount of this decree
" and the costs of this suit, that he proceed to sell the same upon
" judgments at law and that he make report of his
" proceedings in the premises to the February term of
" this Court A.D. 1853 to which time this cause
" stands continued"

On Thursday Nov. 18th the following further
order was entered of record in said Cause viz:

" Francis Benjamin }
" Henry W. Underhill } This day came the defendants

"Wardwell & Shur his attorney presented a motion to
"set aside the default and open the decree heretofore
"made in this cause, which motion is sustained, & the
"Court upon condition that said Wardwell should
"pay the costs accruing under the default, which
"said defendant declined & thereupon the Court
"overruled the motion & said defendant accepted to the
"opinion of the Court in imposing the payment of said
"costs and prayed an appeal to the Supreme Court which
"is granted upon condition that within thirty days from
"this date he shall file an appeal bond herein payable to
"the plaintiffs in the penal sum of one hundred dollars
"with Joseph Shur as security
