by their attorneys and the jury herein
before impanelled, and the jury
having heard the evidence return their
verdict into court which is as
follows to wit, "We the jury find the
defendant guilty and assess the
plaintiff's damages at One Hundred
& Eighty Dollars" and defendant
enters his motion for a new trial
which upon being heard by the Court

is overruled - It is therefore ordered by
the Court that Plaintiff have recovery
of the defendant the said sum of One
Hundred & Eighty - Dollars damages
together with his costs in this behalf
expended & that he have execution
therefor - Whereupon deft prays an
appeal to the Supreme Court which
is granted upon condition that he
file his Bill of Exceptions and his
Appeal Bond in the sum of Five
Hundred Dollars with Charles B
Marshall as security - within Sixty
days from this date
