This day comes the said plaintiff
by D. Ashton his attorney, and the said defendant by
J. W. Mangroff his attorney, also comes, and issue
being joined herein it is ordered that a jury come,
whereupon come the jurors of a jury of good and law-
ful men To-wit: James Ward, L. de Page, W. H. Meyer,
John Ratten, Richard O'Neil, Nicholas Brock, Charles Smith
& B. Mullis, Samuel Heiles, A. M. Pat, Robert Doyle and Thomas

Delhi who being duly elected tried and pronounced
well and truly to try the issue joined aforesaid
and a true verdict-render according to law and
the Evidence used after hearing the Evidence and
arguments of Counsel as well on the part of the plain-
tiff as of the defendant, and instructions from the
Court, retire to consider of their verdict, and
afterwards return into Court and say "The jury
find the issue for the plaintiff and assess his
damages to the sum of Thirty-seven dollars." Whereupon
the defendant by his Counsel moved the Court for
a new trial of said Cause, which motion upon
due consideration thereof overruled, to which ruling

for the sum of Twenty-seven _____ dollars

and _____ cents, besides costs of suit; from which said judgment of the said

Circuit Court, the said Michael W. Bermin _____

has prayed for, and obtained an appeal to the Supreme Court of said State.

Now, Therefore, if the said Michael W. Bermin _____

shall duly prosecute his said appeal with effect, and moreover, pay the amount of the judgment, costs, interest and damages rendered, and to be rendered, against him in case the said

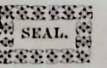
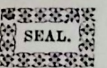
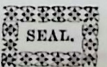
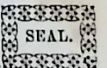
judgment shall be affirmed in said Supreme Court, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
