with our seals and signed with our proper  
hands this 10<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year  
of our Lord 1829

The conditions of the above obligation  
is such that whereas the above bound Peter  
Phillips Jacob Phillips and John Addoms  
had prayed for a writ of Error and  
obtained a writ of Error from the judge-  
ment of the Honourable Thomas C. Brown  
judge of the Circuit Court in and for the  
County of Franklin State of Illinois the  
same being obtained against them the  
said Peter Phillips Jacob Phillips and John  
Addoms by <sup>the said</sup> Chancery Smith in an  
action of Trover brought by the said  
Chancery Smith to recover <sup>said damages</sup> damages which  
was adjudged by the said court to be the  
sum of one hundred and thirty Dollars  
and all costs. Now if the said Peter  
Phillips Jacob Phillips and John  
Addoms shall prosecute with effect  
the said writ of Error, and shall pay  
well and truly satisfy and pay the debt  
or judgment aforesaid and all costs  
and damages which may be awarded
