Whereas, the above named Stephen A. Hurlbut has sued out a writ of Error from said Supreme Court to reverse a judgment which the said Claudian B. Northrup obtained against him in said Circuit Court of Boone County, which said writ of error is now pending in said Supreme Court; and whereas, a writ of scire facias, returnable on the first day of the next term of said Supreme Court, to be holden at Ottawa, in said State of Illinois, on the first Tuesday after the third Monday in April next, has been duly issued herein according to law; and whereas, also, it appears by affidavit, on file in the office of the Clerk of said Supreme Court, that the said Claudian B. Northrup, the said defendant in error is a non-resident of the State of Illinois, and without the reach of the process of said Supreme Court:

Now, therefore, you the said Claudian B. Northrup, the said defendant in error, whose non-residence appears as aforesaid, are hereby notified to be and appear before the Justices of said Supreme Court, to be holden at Ottawa, in said State, on the first Tue day after the third Monday in April next, A. D. 1862, to hear the record and proceedings of said judgment of said Circuit Court brought into said Supreme Court on return of said writ of error and the errors assigned, if you see fit; and further, to do and receive what said Supreme Court shall order in this behalf.
