The People of the State of Illinois
To the Coroner of Wayne County, Greeting;

Whereas it has been made to appear to the Justices of our Supreme Court that the rule heretofore granted at the instance of the People of the State of Illinois on the relation of James M. Duncan late Clerk of our said Court against Charles Wood Sheriff of Wayne County had been duly served upon the said Charles Wood, and the said Charles Wood still being in default by failing and refusing to make due return to the process entrusted to him by the said relator, or to pay over to the said relator the monies by him received thereon. This is therefore to command you, that you take the body of the said Charles Wood if he can be found in your County, and him safely keep, so that you have him personally before our Justices aforesaid on Monday the fourth day of July next, at the term of our Supreme Court to be held at Springfield in the County of Sangamon on the first Monday of July next, that the said Justices of our Supreme Court may then and there do to him what of right ought to be done according to law. Then and there you are to make due return how you have executed this writ.
