Be it remembered that on the 16th day of
Oct. AD 1854, the same being one of the days
of the Oct. Term AD 1852, of the De Kalb County
Circuit Court, among other the following proceed-
ings were had, and entered of Record in words &
figures following, to wit:

This day came the Plaintiff in person, and the Defendants by E. L. Mayo their Attorney, and the Court being fully advised as to the matters submitted to the Court in the stipulation herein filed, orders that judgment be entered for the Plaintiff, and that said Plaintiff be allowed the sum of thirty six Dollars and forty eight Cents for furnishing fuel and lights for the use of the Circuit Clerk's office previous to September 13th 1854.

The following is a copy of the Stipulation filed in said case

James M. Brown vs DeKalb Circuit Court
October Term 1854

the Board of Supervisors of DeKalb County vs Appraisers

It is hereby agreed by and between the parties that this Suit be submitted to the Court without proof or argument on the following state of facts, viz:

1 It is admitted by the defendants that the

Plaintiff is Clerk of the Circuit Court of said County and has discharged the duties thereof since December 1852 up to Sept. 13th 1854

2. It is admitted by the Defendants that during the time included as aforesaid the said Plaintiff, Clerk as aforesaid furnished for the necessary use of the Circuit Clerk's Office, fuel and Lights, and that thirty six Dollars and forty eight Cents would be a just allowance therefor, which the Plaintiff claims

3. It is denied by the Defendants that they are legally bound to allow the aforesaid Claim and herein the said parties join issue, and ask the opinion of the Court.
