-reme Court which is granted conditioned that the Defendant
enter in to Bond in the sum of two hundred and twenty five
Dollars, with Andrew White as security within ten days from
this date,

of Jo Davies and State of Illinois are held and fir-
mly bound unto Orville C Pratt and Van H Higgins

sum of Two Hundred and twenty five dollars for the pay-
ment of which well and truly to be made we do hereby
bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jo-
intly severally, and firmly by these presents,
Witness our hands and seals at Galena Illinois this 14th
day of June A.D. 1849.

The Condition of the above ob-
ligation is such that whereas the said Orville C Pratt &
Van H Higgins did on the Eighth day of June A.D.
1849, in the Circuit Court in and for the County aforesaid
recover a judgment against the above bounden Johnst-
on Gunn for the sum of Eighty Dollars damages and
Fifteen dollars costs from which said judgment of the
said Circuit Court, the said Johnston Gunn has payed
for, and obtained an appeal to the Supreme Court of
said State, Now if the said Johnston Gunn shall duly
prosecute his said appeal with effect, and shall more-
over pay the amount of the judgment cost interest & damages
rendered and to be rendered against him in case the said
judgment shall be affirmed in the said Supreme Court
then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full
force and virtue
