Mr. Justice Lawrence: The same question in regard to the admissibility of intruders is presented in this case as in the ^{preceding} case of ~~Brown~~ vs ~~Hurd~~, decided at the present term of the court. The same facts are presented by this record, the parties being reversed. We held in that case that the partners who had been defaulted were not competent intruders to charge the defendant as a co-partner. We so hold in this case. ~~Reversed. Remanded.~~

The judgment is reversed and the cause remanded.
