Be it remembered that heretofore, to wit, on the thirtieth day of March, in the Year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty said day being one of the days of the March Term of the Superior Court of Chicago the following among other proceedings was had and entered of Record in said Court, to wit,

Mary C. Woolston &
Alfred L. Woolston

vs

John B. King &
Charles B. Wells

And now this cause came on to be heard on bill, answer, replication, and stipulation of certain facts filed in this Court and Counsel being heard and due deliberation being thereupon had and the premises being fully understood the Court finds that the law and equities of the Law are with the defendants.

It is therefore ordered adjudged and decreed by the Court that the Injunction be dissolved and that the bill be dismissed at costs of said Complainants to be taxed, & it is considered that defendants have execution against complainants for costs, And therefore said Complainants pray an appeal

herein to the Supreme Court which is allowed on
filing Bond in sum of two hundred dollars with
J. W. Chickering as security conditional as the law
in such case directs to be filed at any time during
the Term.

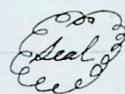
And afterwards, to wit, on the twenty seventh day
of March in the Year aforesaid said day being one
of the days of the aforesaid Term, there was filed in
the office of the clerk aforesaid a certain appeal Bond
in words and figures as follows, to wit,

Know all Men by these presents that we
Alfred D. Woolston and John W. Chickering are
held and firmly bound unto Charles B. Wells &
John B. King in the sum of Two hundred dollars
to the payment of which we bind ourselves our heirs
executors, and administrators jointly and severally
by these presents Sealed with our seals and dated
this 26th day of March 1860.

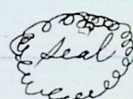
The condition of the above obligation is such that
whereas the said Alfred D. Woolston and Mary
C. Woolston his wife have prayed an appeal to
the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, from
a decree rendered against them, and in favor of
the said Charles B. Wells and John B. King at

the March Term 1860 of said Court, dismissing
the bill of the said Alfred D. Woolston & Mary C.
Woolston, now if the said Alfred D. Woolston
and Mary C. Woolston shall duly prosecute the
said appeal, and pay and satisfy all damages
and costs in case the said decree shall be affirmed
against them in the Supreme Court, or in case
the said appeal shall not be duly prosecuted to
final judgment, then this obligation shall be void,
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue,
