The Court opened by proclamation

But remembered that heretofore
Court on the 18th day of June A D 1839
the same being one of the days of the

June Term, A.D. 1839. of The Court of
Common Pleas of The City of
Lunenburg the following among other
proceedings were had and entered
of Record in said Court To wit!

James A. Wilder } Assumpsit

This day this
cause again coming on on the Default
of Defendant having heretofore been
entered and the clerk ordered to assess
the Plaintiffs damages and the clerk
having reported as due and owing
from the said defendant to the said
Plaintiff the sum of Five Hundred
and Eighty one Dollars & forty four cents
It is ordered that the report be approved
Therefore it is considered by the
Court that Plaintiff have and recover
of Defendant his damages of Five
Hundred & Eighty one Dollars & forty
four cents in form aforesaid assessed
and also his costs and charges about
this suit expended and have execution
therefor.

And afterwards Court, on the
29th day of June A D 1839. the same
still being one of the days of the same
Term A D 1839. aforesaid of said Court
the following among other proceedings
were had and entered of Record in
said Court Court.

James A. Wilder } Assumpsit
This day
comes the defendant by Wagner his
attorney and enters his motion for
an appeal of this cause to the Supreme
Court of the State of Illinois. It is
ordered by the Court that the appeal
be allowed upon Defendant entering
into bonds in the sum of Twelve Hun-
-dred Dollars with Alpheus H Wilder
as security & that he have thirty
days to file his Bill of exceptions herein

And afterwards Court on the
9th day of July A D 1839. there was filed
in the Office of the Clerk of said Court
a certain appeal bond which is in
the words of figures following Court.

Know all men by these presents that we
James A. Hinds as principal ^{and} A. H.
Hinds as surety are held and firmly bound
unto Clark Wilder in the penal sum of
Twelve Hundred Dollars lawful money
of the United States for the payment of
which sum we jointly ^{and} severally bind
ourselves our heirs executors administrators
^{and} assigns ^{and} each of them firmly by
these presents. Witness our hands ^{and} seals
this Second day of July A. D. 1839.

The condition of the above obligation
is such that when as the said Clark
Wilder did at the June Term A. D. 1839
of the Court of Common Pleas of the City
of Aurora in the County of Kane ^{and} State
of Illinois recover a Judgment against
the above bounden James A. Hinds for
the sum of Five Hundred ^{and} Eighty one
dollars ^{and} Forty four cents ^{and} costs of
suit from which Judgment the said
James A. Hinds has taken an appeal
to the Supreme Court of the State of
Illinois. Now if the said James A.
Hinds shall prosecute his appeal with
effect and shall pay the said Judgment
costs interest and damages in case
said Judgment shall be affirmed in said

Supreme Court then the above obligation
to be void otherwise to remain in full
force and effect
