


Know all men by these presents;
That we Joseph Dinet as principal
and Antoine Delfosse of the
City of Chicago, County of Cook and State
of Illinois as surety are held and
firmly bound unto Christian Eei-
genmann of the City of Chicago, afore-
said as administrator of the estate
of Elizabeth Dinet deceased, in the
penal sum of five thousand
dollars, lawful money of the United
States of America, for the payment
of which, well and truly to be
made, we bind ourselves, our
heirs, executors and administra-
tors, jointly, severally, and
firmly by these presents,
Witness our hands and seals this
sixteenth day of November A. D.
1875.

The condition of the above
obligation is such that where-
as one Elizabeth Dinet now de-
ceased did on the seventh day of
August A. D. 1872 in the Criminal
Court of Cook County, and of the Au-
gust term thereof, in the year
last aforesaid, recover two certain
decrees against the above bounden
Joseph Dinet, the first whereof
was for solicitors fees, and the
second for permanent alimony
and to reverse which said decrees

the said Joseph Dinet is about to sue out a writ of Error from the Supreme Court of said State. Now therefore, if the said Joseph Dinet duly prosecute his said writ of Error with effect, and moreover pay the amounts of the said decrees or judgments, costs, interest and damages rendered and to be rendered against him, in case the said decrees or judgments shall be affirmed in said Supreme Court, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
