I know all Men by these presents that we Bird M. Simpson, Jesse M. Wade, William Marshall and John F. Draper are held and firmly bound unto Henry Underhill and Leo. in the penal sum of two hundred dollars, to the payment of which sum well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves, our executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this <sup>sixth</sup> ~~fourth~~ day of December 1832.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas at the September Term 1832 of the Marion Circuit Court Henry Underhill & Leo obtained a Judgment against the above bounden Bird M. Simpson & Jesse M. Wade for the sum of seventy one dollars, to reverse which Judgment the said Simpson & Wade have sued out a writ of Error from the Supreme Court, Now if the said Simpson & Wade shall duly prosecute their said writ of error with effect and abide by the order and decision of the said Supreme Court, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
