The People of the State of Illinois  
to the Sheriff of Randolph County  
greeting.

Whereas it appears by  
the Record of a Judgment which  
was in the Circuit Court of the said  
County of Randolph at the August  
term of said Court in the Year 1829  
that Robert Herbert, Thomas Ganney &  
John D Brown Recovered against John  
C. Herbert and Charles Lourese Tenants  
in possession, this Term as yet to come  
of and in three several pieces one thousand  
four hundred and sixty eight acres  
of land with the appurtenances situated  
in the American Bottom, in the said County  
of Randolph, being the farm formerly owned  
and occupied by Minian Edwards adjoin-  
ing the Common field of Prairie du Rocher  
and the lands attached thereto, bounded on  
the North East by the Hills or ridge of  
Rocks dividing the high from the low ground  
North Westwardly by the prairie du Rocher  
Common field land, South Westwardly by  
the River Mississippi and South Eastwardly  
by a tract of Land claimed by N. Pope  
Which said Judgment of the said Circuit  
Court of Randolph County, was by agreement be-  
tween the said Robert Herbert, Thomas Ganney  
& John D Brown & John C Herbert & Charles  
Lourese by their attorneys submitted for  
the Decision of the said Supreme Court;  
And the said Supreme Court having

had the said judgement under consider-  
ation and having diligently examined and  
inspected the said judgement have approved  
the same in all its parts: Now therefore  
we command you that you cause  
the said Nobles Herbert Thomas Lamy &  
John D Brown to have their possession  
of their Term yet to come of land in  
the aforesaid three tracts and one  
thousand four hundred and sixty eight  
acres of Land with the appurtenances  
situate in the American Bottom in the said  
county of Randolph, being the <sup>farm</sup> formerly owned  
and occupied by Minian Edwards adjoining  
the Common field of Prairie du Rocher and  
the Land attached thereto bounded on the  
North East by the hills or ridge of Rocks cir-  
cumscribing the high from the low grounds, North  
westwardly by the Prairie du Rocher Com-  
mon field Lands South Westwardly by the  
River Mississippi and South Eastwardly by  
a tract of Land claimed by Nathaniel  
Pope and in what manner you  
shall execute this writ make return to  
our said Supreme Court to be holden at  
Vandalia on the first Monday in Decem-  
ber next.
