ty the said land is situated a list

and abstract of all such lands as had
become subject to taxation ~~for the year~~
~~of the year~~ ~~of the year~~ 1842 - That is to say
a list including all lands which had
been purchased of the United States pre-
vious to the first day of January 1837
in which list this tract was furnished by said Au-
ditor the said tract of land before mention-
ed was not included. Your petitioner fur-
ther states that, the appraiser of Marshall
County, appraised the said tract of land
and added it to the list thus furnished
him by the Auditor, and that the
said tract of land, was afterwards
sold, for the taxes of the year 1842
amounting to \$14 50⁰⁰. and ~~paid~~
~~paid~~ off to the State. Your peti-
tioner states that the tract above said
was not subject to taxation, for the
year appraised, and that the appraiser
was not authorized to appraise the same
and that the appraisal and sale was
erroneous. He therefore prays that
an Alternative writ of Mandamus issue
from this Court commanding the Au-
ditor to rescind and avoid the said

fact or show cause to the contrary thereof -
