Be it remembered that heretofore to-wit: at the June Term of said Court. to-wit: on the third day of July in the year aforesaid, the following proceedings. Among others, were had and entered of record. to-wit:-

This Cause came on this day to be heard upon the motion of the defendant heretofore entered to set aside the order dismissing the appeal and the judgment entered therein. And the Court upon hearing Mr. E. Van Buren of Counsel for the plaintiff and Mr. L. L. Boney of Counsel for the defendant, and being fully advised of and concerning the premises doth order that said

motion be and the same hereby is overruled.
Whereupon the said defendant by his Counsel Excepts
to the ruling and decision of the Court in said
Cause, and prays an appeal therefrom to the
Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, which is
granted by the Court upon Condition that the
said defendant shall within ten days from
this date Execute and file with the Clerk of
this Court his appeal Bond herein in the
penal sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars. Con-
ditioned according to law with James McGray as
surety thereto

And afterwards to-wit: on the
Eighth day of July in the year last aforesaid said
defendant filed in said Court his appeal Bond
herein, which is in the words and figures following

Know all men by these presents that
we Edward Snyder as principal & Joseph McGray as
surety are held and firmly bound unto Henry W
Ringland in the penal sum of Two hundred and fifty
dollars for the payment whereof well and truly to be
made we bind ourselves, our heirs, Executors and
administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these
presents. Witness our hands and seals this seventh day
of July A D 1862. The Condition of the foregoing obligation
is such that whereas the above named Henry W Ringland

did on the Third day of July A.D. 1867 at the June Term A.D. 1867 of the Circuit Court within & for the County of Cook in the State of Illinois, recover by the Consideration of said Court a judgment against the above defendant Edward Snyder from which said judgment the said Edward Snyder has taken an appeal to the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois. Now if the said Edward Snyder shall duly prosecute his said appeal and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid the judgment aforesaid, and all costs interests and damages in case the said judgment shall be affirmed by the said Supreme Court, then this obligation shall be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue
