road Company against Richard
A. Gray & wife for \$19.00.
and paid the postage on each
of said writs. That said writs
were addressed to the Sheriff
of St. Clair County, and that
said Thomas Challenor was
Sheriff of said County ^{at said time}, as he
is informed and believes,
and that neither of said
writs have ever been returned
as he believes.
