On ~~*Friday*~~, on the *third Monday of June*

next, that the re cord and proceedings, being inspected, we may cause to be done therein, to correct the error, what of right ought to be done according to law.

Witness, the Hon. William Wilson, Chief Justice of our said Court, and the seal thereof at ^{*Springfield*} ~~*Vandalia*~~, this *29th* day of *May* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *forty*
