Know all men by these presents that we Andrew Nelson and Edwin J Elliott are held and firmly bound unto Lovitt P Rockwell in the Penal Sum of One hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States to which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves our heirs Executors Administrators jointly & severally by these presents witness our hands and seals this sixth day of July A.D. 1852

The Condition of this obligation is this that whereas the above named Andrew Nelson lately sued out of the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois a Writ of Error and a Scire facias to have Error to the Circuit Court of the County of Warren in said State for the purpose of Revising & Rectifying in said Supreme Court a certain decree in Chancery rendered in said court wherein in the said Andrew Nelson was complainant and the said Lovitt P Rockwell was defendant; Now in case the said Andrew Nelson shall duly prosecute his said writ of Error in said Supreme Court, and shall pay the said decree, costs interest and damages in case the said decree shall be affirmed in the said Supreme Court, then this Bond shall be void otherwise in force
