ants, and Henry R. Stevens, orren
Stevens, Sophia Dorey and Peter
Dorey were defendants. That
said appeal was taken & there duly
allowed by said Circuit Court,
upon said appellants filing ^{their} proper
Bond in the penalty of three hundred
dollars with Horion D. A. Parks
as surety within sixty days from that
date - And further certify that
said appellants have perfected their
said appeal by filing their Bond with
said surety in the proper sum within
the required time - by virtue of which
appeal the decree of said Circuit
Court in said cause is now
suspended - And further that
^{neither} said appellants nor any one for
them has applied for any transcripts
or record of said cause - and that
none such has ever been
made out -
