The condition of the above obligation is such that when  
the said John Krower & Benjamin Krower did on the  
12<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1838, in the Municipal Court of the City  
of Chicago, at the April Term thereof, recover against the said  
Nathaniel D. Brown, in ~~the~~ <sup>a</sup> certain action in their favour against  
the said Brown & one George B. Field, a judgement for the sum  
One hundred and fifty three Dollars & thirty seven cents <sup>cents</sup> dan-  
ages, and Eight Dollars, forty ~~th~~ <sup>four</sup> ~~ths~~ <sup>ths</sup> ~~costs~~ <sup>costs</sup>; and when the  
said Nathaniel D. Brown is about to bring a writ of Error to the  
Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, upon said judgement,  
Now therefore, if the said Brown shall pay the said

ment shall be affirmed, and also shall duly prosecute

that they be and appear before the Judges of our said Supreme Court, at the next term of said Court, to be holden at Vandalia, in said State, on the 9<sup>th</sup> Monday in December next, to hear the records and proceedings aforesaid, and the errors assigned, if they shall think fit; and further to do and receive what the said Court shall order in this behalf; and have you then there the names of those by whom you shall give the said John Knower & Benjamin Knower notice, together with this writ.
