Be it remembered that on the fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and fifty six the said being one of the days of the November term of said Court the following among other proceedings were had to wit,
"William McKee

} Trespass

This day again comes the said defendant by his attorney and prays an appeal of this cause to the Supreme Court. which is allowed by the Court, and leave is given to the said defendant

to file his bill of Exceptions and Bond to be approved by the Clerk in ten days from the date hereof."

And afterwards to wit on the fifteenth day of January in the year aforesaid the said defendant Koeffler filed in the office of the Clerk of said Court his appeal bond in said cause, which is in words and figures as follows, that is to say,

"Know all men by these presents, That we Gustavus Koeffler and Louis Waudette of the County of Cook in the State of Illinois are held and firmly bound unto William McKee his heirs, Executors, administrators ^{in the sum of four hundred dollars} and assigns for which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs, Executors & administrators, jointly & severally firmly by these presents, Sealed with our seals and dated this fifteenth day of January A. D. 1856.

The Condition of this obligation is such, that whereas on the fifth day of December A. D. 1855 at the November term 1855, of the Circuit Court of the County of Cook in the State of Illinois a judgment was rendered in and by said Court against the above bounden Gustavus Koeffler in favor of the said William McKee for the sum of One hundred and seventy five dollars besides costs from which said judgment the said Gustavus Koeffler has prayed an appeal to the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, Now therefore if the said

Gustavus Koeffler shall duly prosecute his said appeal and pay the judgment costs interest & damages in case the judgment of said Circuit Court shall be affirmed then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.
