"parties by their respective attorneys and  
"after arguments of counsel the court being  
"fully advised as to the motion for a new  
"trial heretofore entered herein overrules  
"the same, to which decision of the court

" the said plaintiff excepts, whereupon it is  
" ordered that the said defendants have  
" and recover of the said plaintiff their  
" costs and charges by them in this behalf  
" expended, and that they have execution  
" therefor, and afterwards comes the said  
" plaintiff and prays an appeal herein to  
" the supreme court which is granted on  
" condition that the said plaintiff enters  
" into bond before the clerk of this court  
" within twenty days from this date in the  
" penal sum of five hundred dollars  
" with E. Peys Ferry and Isaac S.  
" Clark as sureties, and it is further or-  
" dered that the said plaintiff have  
" two weeks from this date in which to  
" file his bill of exceptions herein

" And it is further ordered that  
" all the witnesses who were sworn and  
" testified on the part of the said defend-  
" ants on the trial of this cause were  
" really necessary.
