Filed before the Honorable V. M. Purple at a circuit court, began and held at the court house in Nashville Schuyler County Illinois on Monday the 1st day of Sept 1843
And afterwards doct on the 3 day of September 1843 of the Schuyler County Circuit Court the following order was made herein to wit

In Ejectment

This day came the parties by their attorneys and for trial put themselves upon the Country and thereupon came the Jurors of a Jury to wit Samuel McCreary Joseph Purdy Thomas Goodwin Joshua Whitwood Alexander Brazetton William Edger Allen Persinger Horace P. Pitt Alexander Montgomery John Sellers John Semott & Theodore D. Ray who being elected tried and sworn well and truly to try the issue joined after hearing the evidence upon their oaths do say see the Jury find that the said defendant is guilty of unlawfully withholding the premises in the Declaration mentioned to wit the South East quarter of Section five in township three North Range four West from the said plaintiff and that the said plaintiff is well entitled to hold the same in fee as the said plaintiff hath in his said Declaration alleged against him the said Defendant and they assess the Damages of the said plaintiff by reason of the premises aforesaid to one cent, It is therefore considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover of the Defendant the aforesaid sum of one cent Damages and also the possession of the premises above described, Whereupon the plaintiff prays the writ of the people of the state of Illinois to be directed to the Sheriff of Schuyler County Illinois to cause him to have possession of

the said premises according to the force and effect of said recovery and it is granted &c and it further ordered that the plaintiff recover of the Defendant his Costs about his suit expended and may have execution, and thereupon the Defendant prayed an appeal to the Supreme Court which is granted upon that Condition that that the said Defendant shall within thirty days from the adjournment of this Court enter into Bond with David Atkins and James G King as his Securities in the penal sum of three Hundred Dollars
