This is a Suit by the Plaintiff as public administrator, administering on the Estate of John Thow deceased for rent accrued under a lease made by him as such administrator of the lands of the deceased. The plaintiff recovered of the defendant the sum of one hundred and four Dollars and Cost. It is agreed by the parties that the Cause may be taken to the Supreme Court, and there determined upon the question, whether a public administrator, administering upon a particular Estate together with all authority that can be conferred on him by the Probate Justice of the Peace, has by law, authority to lease the real Estate of the deceased. If decided in the affirmative the Judgment to be affirmed, otherwise to be reversed. A certified Copy of this Agreement to be the only portion of the Record taken to the Supreme Court.
