At a term of the Circuit Court begun and held at the Court House, in the City of Pekin, in, and for the County of Tazewell and State of Illinois, on the first Monday of February in the Year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and sixty, it being the 6th day of said Month, Present the Hon. James Harriott, Judge of the 21<sup>st</sup> Judicial Circuit, in the State of Illinois, Hugh Fullerton, States Attorney.

Among other things, the following proceedings were had, to wit:

And now on this day came again, as well the Plaintiffs, by their attorney, S. D. Puterbaugh, as the Defendants, by their Attorney B. S. Pallyman; and by agreement of Parties hereto, a jury is waived, and this cause is tried by the Court. And the Court having heard the proofs and allegations of

the parties and argument of Counsel thereon, and being fully advised in the premises, is of the opinion that the Plaintiffs hath sustained damages by reason of the breaches of promises, in the Declaration mentioned, to the sum of Two hundred twenty eight &  $45/100$  - dollars ( $\$228.\frac{45}{100}$ ).

It is therefore ordered and adjudged, by the Court, that the Plaintiffs recover of said defendants, the damages, aforesaid, and likewise the costs and Charges by them about their suit expended, and that Execution issue therefor.

Whereupon the Defendants moved the Court for a new trial, which said motion, the Court overruled.

Thereupon the Defendants prayed an appeal, which is allowed by the Court, with Bond <sup>to</sup> approved by the Clerk, & to be filed, by agreement of parties, on or before the 5<sup>th</sup> of March next.
