And now again comes the parties to this suit by their respective attorneys as aforesaid, and the Court having had the issues involved herein under advisement since the 28th day of May last past, and the Court being now fully advised gives issues for plaintiff and assesses his damages herein to the sum of Seventy two Dollars and Ninety six Cents.

Therefore it is considered said plaintiff do have and recover of the said defendant his damages of Seventy two Dollars and Ninety six Cents in form aforesaid by the Court here found and assessed, and also his costs and charges in this behalf expended and have execution therefor.

And afterwards to wit, on the 16th day of the month and year aforesaid, said day being one of the days of said term of said Court the following among other proceedings was had and entered of Record in this Court. to wit:

And now again comes the said Defendant and prays an Appellant herein to the Supreme Court, which is allowed on filing Appellant Bond in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars with O. H. Lull as his Security thereon.

And thereupon defendant files his Bond conditioned as aforesaid, and replied.

And thereupon the said Defendant, to wit: on the day & year last aforesaid, filed in the office of the Clerk of said Court, his certain Appellant Bond, in the words & figures following to wit:

Know all men by these presents that we John S. Reed and Oliver A. H. Lull of the County of Cook and State of Illinois are here and jointly bound unto Daniel Stearns of the County of Cook in the State of Illinois in the penal sum of Two Hundred Dollars current money of the United States for the payment of which well truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and Admini-

istrators jointly & severally, firmly by these Presents.
Witness our hands & seals at Chicago this 14th
day of July A. D. 1859.

The Condition of the above obligation
is such, that whereas the said Daniel Stearns died
on the seventh day of July A. D. 1859. in the Superior
Court of Chicago in the County of Cook & State
of Illinois recover a judgment against the above
bondman John S. Reed for the sum of Seventy two
Dollars and ninety six Cents Damages and
Dollars and Cents Costs from which judg-
ment of the said Superior Court of Chicago the
said John S. Reed has prayed for and obtained
an appeal to the Supreme Court of the State of
Illinois.

Now if the said John S. Reed shall prose-
cute his appeal with effect and shall moreover
pay the amount of the judgment costs, interest &
damages rendered to be rendered against him in
case the said judgment shall be affirmed in the
said Supreme Court, then the above obligation
shall be void, and otherwise to remain in full force
& Virtue.
