AD 1859 at the aforesaid term of Court then being
held the following order was entered upon the
Records of said Court which is in the words and
figures following to wit:

This day came on
this cause for hearing on the defendants motion
for a new trial and an arrest of judgment
and after hearing the argument of Counsel thereon
it is ordered by the Court that the motion be over-
ruled, Therefore it is considered by the Court
that the Plaintiffs recover of the said defendant
the sum of Twenty Dollars the amount of fine
imposed by the Court together with their costs
by them in this suit expended, and that the
defendant stand committed until fine and costs
are paid. Thereupon came the defendant by his
attorney and pray the Court for an appeal
to the Supreme Court, which is allowed by the

Court upon the defendant entering into security
in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars with Liberty
Gilmon & Hugh Gamble as security. Bond and Bill
of Exceptions to be filed during the present term
of this Court;

Afterwards to wit; On the 13th day of April A.D. 1859,
the said William M. Gilmon filed an appeal
Bond in the foregoing case, which said Bond is
in the words and figures following to wit;

Know all men by these presents that we William
M. Gilmon and Liberty M. Gilmon and Hugh Gamble
are held and firmly bound unto the People of the
State of Illinois in the penal sum of Two Hun-
dred Dollars for the payment of which well and
truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs, executors
and administrators jointly severally and firmly
by these presents, Witness our hands and seals this
11th day of April Anno Domini one thousand eight
hundred and fifty nine. The condition of the
above obligation is such; That whereas the People
of the State of Illinois did on the 11th day of
April 1859 in the Circuit Court within and
for the County of Warren and State of Illinois

recover a Judgment against the above bounden
William W. Gilmore for the sum of Twenty
Dollars and Costs of prosecution from which
Judgment of said Circuit Court the said Will-
iam W. Gilmore shall duly prosecute his appeal
with effect and shall moreover pay the am-
ount of the Judgment Costs interest and dam-
ages rendered and to be rendered against him
in case the said Judgment shall be affirmed
in the said Supreme Court then the above obli-
gation to be null and void, otherwise to rem-
ain in full force and virtue.
