"That the Plaintiff have and recover of the Defendants the said sum of One hundred and eighteen Dollars and sixty nine cents, so as aforesaid found by the Court and Jury, less the Plaintiff's mitted as aforesaid of Twenty Five Dollars and Sixty Four Cents, together with their costs by them about this suit in this behalf expended and that execution issue therefor. To all of which ruling and decisions the Defendants by their attorney excepts."

The appeal Bond, ^{filed by the Defendants} in
the above entitled cause is in the words
and figures following to-wit:

"Know all men by these presents that we
Dennis Galvin, Thomas Guannelle and John
Plyhitt and Henry Marford are
well and firmly bound unto Edwin
Ripley, Esq. C. Ripley and Mark & Brown
Partners trading and doing business
under name and style of Ripley, Brown & Co
in the penal sum of Three hundred Dollars
for the payment of which well and truly to be
made we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors
and Administrators, jointly, jointly and several-
ly, with our hands and seals this
eighth day of December A.D. 1857.

The consideration of the above
obligation is such that whereas the ^{above named} ~~said~~
Ripley, Brown & Co did at the October term of
the Circuit Court of Jackson County Illinois
recover a judgment ^{against} the above bounden
Dennis Galvin, Thomas Guannelle John Plyhitt
and Chas McDonald for the sum of nearly
five hundred Dollars, costs from ^{what} judgment
the said Galvin, Guannelle & Plyhitt have to
appeal to the Supreme Court of the State of
Illinois third Grand Division - now of

The said Dennis Galvin, Thomas Guannelle
or John P. Riphitti shall prosecute & then
said appeal with effect and shall
well and truly pay whatever judgment
may be awarded by the Court against
them, then the above obligation to be
void otherwise to remain in full force
and effect.
