The parties by their attorneys come and the Plaintiffs
by their attorneys moves the court to strike the defendants
pleas in abatement from the files which motion after
argument of counsel and due deliberation thereon is allow-
ed. Thereupon it is ordered by the court that said pleas in
abatement be stricken from the files of this court, and
the defendants having failed further to plead in their
behalf and being three times solemnly called come
not nor any person for them to defend this suit but made
default. It is therefore considered by the court that the said
plaintiffs have and recover of the said defendants their
damages and as those damages are unknown to the court
It is ordered by the court that the clerk assess the same and
the clerk having assessed and reported the damages at the
sum of Two Hundred and Eight dollars and sixty one
cents. It is therefore considered by the court, that the Plainti-
ffs have and recover of the said defendants the said sum
of Two Hundred and Eight Dollars and sixty one cents the
damages assessed as aforesaid together with their costs
and Charges in this suit laid out and expended.

Thereupon the defendants come and pray an appeal
to the Supreme Court which is allowed by the court. The
defendants to file Bill of Exceptions & Bond by agreement with
judicial sum of Five Hundred dollars with security to be approved
by the clerk in sixty days.
