Thomason shall perform all the duties  
required to be performed by him as collector  
of the County of Moultrie in the time and  
manner prescribed by law and when he  
shall be succeeded in office shall surrender  
and deliver over to his successor in office  
all books papers and moneys belonging to  
said County or to the State of Illinois and  
appertaining to his said office then the above  
bond to be void otherwise to remain in full  
force

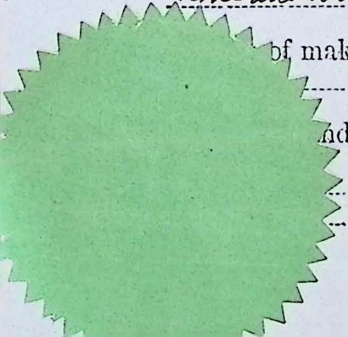
