The People of the State of Illinois,

To the Sheriff of the County of *Cook* Greeting:

that *he* be and appear before the justices of our said supreme court, at the next term of said court, to be holden at Ottawa, in said state, on the *second Monday in June* next, to hear the records and proceedings aforesaid, and the errors assigned, if *he* shall see fit; and further to do and receive what said court shall order in this behalf; and have you then there the names of those by whom you shall give the said *Pitcher* notice, together with this writ.
