I, William Hulin, clerk of the
County Court of said County, do hereby certify,
that on the Eleventh day of September last,
(A. D. 1860,) in a certain appeal from
a Justice's Court pending in said County
Court wherein Worcester A. Dickerman,
Goodyear A. Sanford and Robert P. Lane
were Plaintiffs and respondents and Orren
Miller was defendant and appellant,
Judgment was rendered in said County
Court in favor of said Plaintiffs and
against said Defendant on a promissory

note for the sum of (\$38.55) thirty eight dollars and fifty five cents, besides costs, whereupon said defendant prayed an appeal to the Supreme Court from the said Judgment, which appeal was granted on condition that said defendant with James G. Manlove as surety should file his appeal Bond in the sum of One Hundred dollars within ten days from the rising of said Court: that afterwards, and on the thirteenth day of September last (A. D. 1860) the said Defendant filed his said Bond in accordance with said order, and that since that time no action has been had in said Cause, and no application been made on the part of said defendant for the record of said Suit to be transmitted to the Supreme Court.
