

The People of the State of Illinois,

To the Sheriff of *White* County, greeting. —

BECAUSE in the record and proceedings, and also in the rendition of the judgment, of plea which was in the Circuit Court of *White* County, before the Judge thereof, between *Bliss, Williams & Co. plaintiffs,*
and *William Perryman* —

defendant, it is said that manifest error hath intervened to the injury of the said *Bliss, Williams & Co.* as we are informed by *their* complaint, the record and proceedings of which said judgment, we have caused to be brought into our Supreme Court of the State of Illinois, at Vandalia, before the Judges thereof, to correct the errors in the same, in due form and manner, according to law; therefore we command you, that by good and lawful men of your county, you give notice to the said *William Perryman* —

that *he* be and appear before the Judges of our said Supreme Court, at the next term of said Court, to be holden at Vandalia, in said State, on the *10th* Monday in *June*, next, to hear the records and proceedings aforesaid, and the errors assigned, if *he* shall think fit; and further to do and receive what the said Court shall order in this behalf; and have you then there the names of those by whom you shall give the said *William Perryman* — notice, together with this writ.

Witness, the Hon. William Wilson, Chief Justice of our said Court, and the seal thereof, at Vandalia, this *18th* day of *Dec.* in the year of our Lord, 1837.
