of and from the said William Kellogg, William I. Moss, Henry
Lightner, Richard Gregg, Charles I. Clark and James Knox the sum
of Five Hundred and Forty three Dollars and Seventy two cents their
damages in form aforesaid assessed and also their costs and charges
by them about this suit in their behalf expended and that they
have Executions therefor.
