It is therefore considered by the Court that the
defendant have and possess of the plaintiff his cars
and charges of him herein expended and that he
have execution therefor. It is also further ordered
that a writ of Habeas Corpus issue herein.

And now the plaintiff by his counsel prays the
Court for an appeal herein to the Supreme Court
of this State, which is granted upon condition

that plaintiff within thirty days from this date give a bond payable to the defendant in the penal sum of five hundred dollars with John H. McMillan or William Paul as his security
