This day this cause coming on, on the de-  
fendants Motion for a new trial herein, it is con-  
sidered by the Court that said Motion be overruled.  
And again came the defendant by his attorney  
and moved the Court in arrest of Judgment herein,  
which Motion is overruled by the Court. And it is con-  
sidered by the Court that the plaintiff have and recover of  
and from the said defendant the possession of the  
premises named in his the said plaintiffs Com-  
plaint herein, to wit: Lot 18<sup>th</sup> in the town of  
Ferristown, and that he have suit of possession  
therefor,

And it is further Ordered by the Court that the Plaintiff have and recover of and from the said Defendant his costs in this behalf expended, as well in the Court below as in this Court and may have execution therefor.

And now came the Defendant by his Attorney, and prayed an appeal to the Supreme Court herein, which is allowed, the said Defendant to enter into bond with security to be approved by the Clerk of this Court by agreement in the sum of three hundred dollars, and it is further ordered by the Court that the defendant file his bill of exceptions herein within thirty days.
