said property so attached, to be his - To
which Interpleader said Johnson filed
his answer, denying the allegations,
in said Interpleader - The issue thus
joined was tried in said Court, and
a verdict and judgment thereon
entered for and in favor of said
Birmingham and against said Johnson,
