aforesaid did on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February A.D. 1836  
in the Circuit Court in and for the County and State of  
- said recover a judgement against the above bounden  
David Ditch for the sum of forty two dollars and seventy  
five Cents debt, also forty five dollars and forty Cents dam-  
- ages, and six dollars six and one fourth Cents costs from  
which said judgement of the said Circuit Court the  
said David Ditch has prayed for and obtained a  
writ of Error to the Supreme Court of said State, Now  
if the said David Ditch shall duly prosecute his  
said writ of error with effect and shall moreover  
pay the ~~judgement~~ amount of the judgement costs interest  
and damages rendered and to be rendered against him  
in case the judgement shall be affirmed in the said Sup-  
- reme Court then the above Obligation to be void other-  
wise to remain in full force and virtue -
