And afterward to wit on the Thirteenth day of June A.D. 1866. said day being one of the days of the June Term thereof, the following among other proceedings were had and entered of Record in said Court to wit

Alfred W. Davidson, }
Edward L. Gray } Assumpit.

This day comes said Plaintiff by J. L. Beveridge his attorney, and said defendant in his own proper person also comes and upon agreement of the parties made now here in open Court this cause is submitted to the Court for

trial on issues joined without intervention of a Jury and the Court now here after hearing evidence and arguments of Counsel finds issues for Plaintiff and assess his damages herein to the sum of One Hundred and eighty eight dollars eighty eight Cents. And thereupon defendant submits his motion for a new trial herein which motion for a new trial is overruled.

Therefore it is Considered that said Plaintiff do have and recover of said defendant his damages of One Hundred and eighty eight dollars and eighty eight Cents in form aforesaid by the Court here found and assessed together with his Costs and charges in this behalf expended and have execution therefor.

And thereupon said defendant having entered his exceptions herein prays an appeal herein to the Supreme Court of this State. which is allowed on filing his Appeal Bond in the sum of One Hundred dollars with Security to be approved of by a Judge of Court during this term of the Court.

And afterwards to wit on the twenty second day of June AD 1860 there was filed in the office of the Clerk aforesaid a certain appeal bond which is in the words and figures following. to wit:

Know all men by these presents, that Edward G Asay of the City of Chicago as principal and Francis Bracken of same place as security, are held and firmly bound unto Alfred W Davidson of said City in the penal sum of Three Hundred dollars (\$300-) good and lawful money of the United States for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, the said Alfred W Davidson we do bind ourselves, and our Heirs, Executors and administrators, jointly severally and firmly by these presents.

Witness, our hands and seals this Twenty seventh day of June AD 1860.

The Condition of the above obligation is such, That, whereas the above named Alfred W Davidson did, at the June Term of the Superior Court of Chicago held in and for the County of Cook in the State of Illinois AD 1860 recover a judgment

against the above bounden Edward I Asay for the sum of One Hundred eighty eight dollars and eighty eight cents to reverse which said judgment. the said Edward I Asay has taken an to the Supreme Court. within and for the Third Grand Division of said State.

Now if the said Edward I Asay shall duly prosecute said appeal and pay, or Cause to be paid, the amount of said Judgment, and all Judgments, Costs, interest and damages which the said Supreme Court shall adjudge against him and abide the order and judgment of said Supreme Court in this behalf, then this obligation is to be void.
