Whereupon said defendant by their said attorneys, enter their motion for a new trial herein which motion, after hearing the arguments of counsel is ^{overruled} by the Court, to which ruling of the Court the defendants then and there excepted. It is therefore considered by the Court that said plaintiffs have and recover of said Defendants Daniel D. Guiles and Montford S. Andrews said sum of Five hundred and Nine dollars and fifty three cents for their damages and also their
