And now on this day comes the said plaintiff by Light his Attorney and the defendant by Meix his Attorney, and after Argument of Counsel and the Court being fully advised in the premises the defendants motions in arrest of Judgment & for a new Trial are overruled, And it is considered by the Court that the said Plaintiff have and recover of the said defendant the sum of Seventy six Dollars and forty cents debt and one Hundred and fifty Three Dollars and Eight cents damages together with his costs of suit in this behalf expended, and that he have execution therefor.

within thirty days, with Chester K. Williams or
Thomas H. McClure or Henry A. Hois as surety.

well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs ex-

Seals this 27th day of June AD 1857

The Condition of the above obligation is such that
whereas the above named Delevan & Sherwood at the
June Term of the Circuit Court of Ogle County Illinois
at the Term of said Court begun and holden at Oregon
in said County on the first day of June AD 1857 and
on the thirteenth day of said June did recover a Judg-
ment against the above bounden John D Stephenson
in an action of Debt for the sum of seventy Six Dol-
lars and forty cents debt and one hundred and
fifty three Dollars and eighty cents damages and
costs of suit from which Judgment the said Stephe-
son prayed an appeal to the Supreme Court of this
State for the Northern or third Division thereof Now
if the said John D Stephenson shall well and truly

"pay whatever Judgments costs interests and damage
"shall be rendered in said Supreme Court in case the
"Judgment shall be affirmed and shall also well
"and truly prosecute his said appeal then this obli-
"gation to be void otherwise to remain in full force
"and virtue
