Piggott Alfred Cowles and Benjamin W. Edwards are
firmly bound unto Nancy Ramo widow of George Ramo
deceased, Foster Ramo, Michael Palmier & Elizabeth his
wife, Polly Ramo, John Smith and Eliza his wife,
William Ramo, Catharine Ramo, & Thaddeus W. Ramo
Heirs of George Ramo deceased for the payment of eight
hundred and fifty dollars to them well and truly to be
made to the said Ramos and Michael Palmier & Eliza
his wife and John Smith & Eliza his wife, their executors
or administrators which payment to the aforesaid parties
well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves
and our heirs Executors and administrators jointly, severally and
firmly by these presents - (Witness our hands and seals this
twenty sixth day of June A D eighteen hundred & thirty three

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas
the said obligor did on the twentieth day of September
eighteen hundred and thirty one before the Monroe Circuit
Court for the County of Monroe and State of Illinois
obtain a judgement against the above bounden Levi Piggott
for the sum of Three hundred eighty nine dollars, twenty
nine cents, the debt in the declaration mentioned and
thirty nine dollars and eighty seven and one half cents
damages for detention of that debt - upon which said
judgement the said Levi Piggott is prosecuting

a writ of Error from the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois with supersedeas - Now if the said Levi Piggott shall duly prosecute his said writ of Error with effect, and shall moreover pay the amount of the Judgement, costs, interests and damages, rendered and to be rendered against him, in case the said judgement shall be affirmed in the said Supreme Court, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise the same remain in full force and virtue -
