Jackson County Circuit Court December 1860

At a Special Term of the Jackson County Circuit Court
begun and held in the Court House in the Town of Murphys-
boro Jackson County State of Illinois on Monday December
3rd 1860

Present the Honorable Alexander McJannet Judge of the 3^d
Judicial Circuit and Presiding Judge of the Jackson County
Circuit Court.

And now on this day the following Order was made

And now on this day came the parties Plaintiffs and defendants
and by their Attorneys and waived Trial By Jury and Submitted
the Issue to the Court, Whereupon the Court after hearing the
evidence and arguments of Counsel and mature Consideration
Renders Judgment against the defendants B. M. Parrish and
Thomas Parrish for the Sum of Twenty Eight dollars and
Sixty five Cents together with 6 per Cent Damages for Delay.
It is therefore Ordered by the Court that the Plaintiffs have Judg-
ment and do receive of and from the defendants the Sum
of Twenty Eight dollars and Sixty five Cents, together with
6 per Cent Damages for Delay and the Costs of this Suit, Where-
upon the defendants bring an Appeal to the Supreme Court
of the State of Illinois, which Appeal is granted by
Defendants filing Bond in the penal Sum of One hundred
Dollars with Davis Cox as Security. Bond to be filed within
Twenty days from this date.

And afterwards to Wit on the 28th day of December 1860
the following Bond was filed which is worded as follows to Wit:

Know all men by these presents that We Braxton M
Parrish, Thomas Parrish and Davis Cox are held and firmly
bound unto Martha Brayshaw in the full sum of One
hundred Dollar lawful Money of the United States for the
payment of which well and truly to be paid We bind ourselves
Our heirs, executors and Administrators jointly, firmly and
severally by these presents. Witness Our hands and Seals this
28th day of December 1860.

The Condition of this obligation is Such that Whereas the
said Martha Brayshaw did on the eight day of Decem-
ber 1860 before the Circuit Court in and for the County
of Jackson and State of Illinois against the above
bonded Braxton M Parrish and Thomas Parrish
for the sum of \$28.41. and Costs of Suit and Six
per cent for delay from which judgment the said Brax-
ton M Parrish and Thomas Parrish has taken appeal
to the Supreme Court of the State of Illinois. Now if the
said Braxton M Parrish and Thomas Parrish Shall duly
prosecute their Appeal and with effect and Shall pay the
judgments interests Costs and Damages in Case said judg-
ment shall be affirmed then the above obligation
shall be void Otherwise to remain in full force and
virtue
