"The jury having heard the evidence and the Cause having been submitted to them by the Court return Their Verdict into Court which is as follows

"We the jury find the issues for the Plaintiff and assess his damages in the sum of Thirteen Hundred & Eighty One dollars and Forty five cents" whereupon the defendant moves for a new trial. Feby 8th This motion Overruled by the Court. Whereupon the Defendant prays an appeal from the verdict, and judgment of this Court to the Supreme Court of this State. Which is granted on Condition, that he file his bill of Exceptions & Bond for the sum of Two Thousand dollars to be approved by the Clerk within Forty days from this date of Feby 8th 1861. The Court also awards to Plaintiff in Case the Appeal granted, is not effected, a Special Execution for his damages in the sum of Thirteen Hundred & Eighty One dollars & forty five cents together with his Costs in this behalf expended "
