of the Circuit Court in and for said County do hereby certify, that the above entitled case was appealed to said Court, from a justice of the peace, and that on the ~~fourteenth~~<sup>fourteenth</sup> day of November A.D. 1853 a transcript of the proceedings of the justice in said case and the papers pertaining thereto were filed in my office and at the November Term of said Court A.D. 1853. To wit on the ~~thirteenth~~<sup>thirteenth</sup> day of December A.D. 1853 said case was tried before said Court and a jury and that said jury after hearing the evidence in said case and the arguments of counsel and the charge of the Court retired in charge of an officer to consider of their verdict and that on the said ~~thirteenth~~<sup>thirteenth</sup> day of December A.D. 1853 said jury returned into Court the following verdict to wit, "The jury find for the plaintiff & assess his damages at Fifty five dollars and thereupon it was ordered and adjudged by said Court that the said plaintiff have & recover of and from the said defendant the said sum of Fifty five dollars - together with costs of suit and that a special execution be issued directing the sale of said Schooner to satisfy said judgment and costs.

And I further certify that at said Term of said Circuit Court, to wit on the ~~thirteenth~~<sup>thirteenth</sup> day of December A.D. 1853 an appeal was prayed, for and on behalf

of said Schooner & The Supreme Court of the State  
of Illinois and which appeal was granted by  
said Court on the condition that Charles J. Majill  
& Ethan A. Bovee enter into bond and security in  
the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars payable to  
said plaintiff and file the same with the Clerk  
of said Circuit Court ~~within~~ ~~days from the~~  
~~date of granting said appeal~~

And I further certify that said appeal was per-  
fected by a bond being filed in my office as re-  
quired by said Circuit Court within the time fixed  
by said Court for perfecting said appeal and that  
by virtue of said appeal all proceedings in said  
case have been stayed, all of which appears of  
record in my office.
