supreme court of the State of Illinois which appeal was
allowed by the court on condition that the complainant
give Bond in the penal sum of Five hundred dollars
to be filed in said cause by the 11th day of April
A.D. 1854 said bond to be approved by the Clerk
of said court.

Which said Bond was filed in
said court on the 11th day of April A.D. 1854 and
is in the words & figures following to wit

Know all men by these presents
that we Marcus G. Langdon of Castletown in the State
of Vermont as principals and William Moulton
of Castletown as security are held and firmly bound
unto Rollin W. Wheeler Cyrus S. Wheeler Sheldon
Wheeler & Oliver L. Johnson all of Wendell County
in the State of Illinois in the just and full sum of
Five Hundred Dollars of lawful money of the United
States to be paid to them their Executors Administrators
or assigns for which payment well & truly to be made
we do bind ourselves our heirs Executors & administrators
firmly by these presents. Witness our hands & seals this
1st day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand
Eight hundred fifty-four

The condition of this Obligation
is such that whereas at the February Term of the Kane
County Circuit Court held in & for the county of Kane
& State of Illinois in the year of our Lord One
Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty-four in a certain
cause pending on the Chancery side of said Circuit Court
wherein Marcus G. Langdon is complainant and

& the above named Rollin W. Wheeler Cyrus J. Wheeler
 Sheldon Wheeler and Oliver L. Wheeler Johnson are
 defendants impleaded with Alanson W. Wheeler it
 was among other things in effect ordered adjudged
 and decreed that the complainants bill of complaint
 be dismissed without prejudice at the cost of complainants
 from which said Order & decree of said Court, said
 Lamydon by his counsel did then & there
 appeal which was then & there granted by
 Court to take effect upon the filing of this bond now
 if the said Marcus G. Lamydon shall well & truly pay
 all costs interest & damages accruing against the
 said complainant in case the judgment & decree
 of said Court be affirmed and shall duly prosecute
 said appeals, then this bond to be void otherwise
 of full force & virtue
